THE FIXATION OF LIQUID MILK PRICE (AMENDMENT)
(NO. 2) REGULATIONS 1978

(Commencement: 1st September, 1978)

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Act and after consultation with the Dairy Board, the Honourable the Minister for Agriculture is pleased to make the following regulations —

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fixation of Liquid Milk Prices (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1978.

Amendment of Regulation 2 of the Fixation of Liquid Milk Prices Regulations 1972.

2. Regulation 2 of the above Regulations is amended by replacing the words "73 cents per 4.5 litres" by the words "81 cents per 4.5 litres".

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 72 OF 1978

THE DAIRY ACT NO. 28 OF 1968

LEVY ON MILK AND DAIRY PRODUCTS REGULATIONS, 1978

(Under section 25)

(Commencement: 1st September, 1978)

The Honourable the Minister for Agriculture has been pleased to impose the following levies on milk and dairy products to be paid to the Swaziland Dairy Board constituted under the Dairy Act, No. 28 of 1968, on the recommendation of such Board, as from the 1st September, 1978 until further notice.

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Levy on Milk and Dairy Products Regulations, 1978.

Levies to be paid by Producers and Importers of Milk.

2. All importers of milk and all producers of milk produced in Swaziland save and except such producers who sell milk to the processing plant of the Swaziland Dairy Board, shall pay the following levies —

- (a) an administrative levy of 0.52 cents per litre;
- (b) a special levy of 0.11 cents per litre.

Levies to be paid by Manufacturers and Importers of butter, cheese and butterfat.

3. All manufacturers and importers of butter, cheese and butterfat shall pay the following levies —

- (1) In respect of butter —
 - (a) an administrative levy of 3.80 cents per kilogramme;
 - (b) a special levy of 0.15 cents per kilogramme.
- (2) In respect of cheese —
 - (a) an administrative levy of 0.50 cents per kilogramme;
 - (b) a special levy of 0.38 cents per kilogramme.
- (3) In respect of butterfat —
 - (a) an administrative levy of 0.50 cents per kilogramme;
 - (b) a special levy of 0.50 cents per kilogramme.

Repeal of Legal Notice No. 3 of 1972.

4. Legal Notice No. 3 of 1972 is hereby repealed.

MAXIMUM WHOLESALE AND RETAIL PRICES OF BREAD

(Date of Commencement: 20th. October, 1978)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the abovementioned order, I hereby prescribe the maximum wholesale and retail selling prices of bread in Swaziland to be as set out in the schedule to this notice.

2. In this notice the term "bread" and "fancy bread" shall have the meaning assigned to them in the "Weights and Measures" (Sale of bread) Regulation, 1977 (Legal Notice No. 51 of 1977).

3. This notice shall not apply to fancy bread.

4. This notice repeals Legal Notice No. 31 of 1978.
