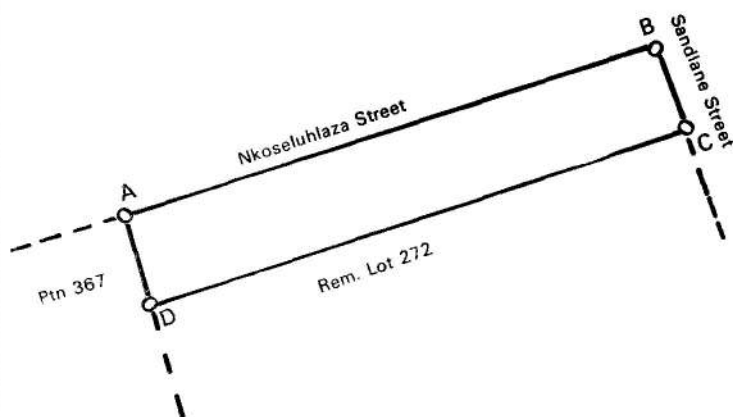
1. This Notice may be cited as the Proclamation of Ngwane V Inquiry National Monument Notice, 1984.

THE POST OFFICE ACT, 1962

(Act, No. 60 of 1962)

THE POSTAL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1984

(Under regulation 4)

In exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 4 of the Post Office Regulations, 1962 the Minister for Works and Communications hereby makes the following Regulations—
Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Postal (Amendment) Regulations, 1984, shall be read as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1962 and shall come into force on the 1st August, 1984.

Amendment of Schedule B.

2. Schedule B. of the Post Office Regulations, 1962 is amended in Part I,II,III,IV and V by replacing the postage rates therein with the rates in the Schedule hereto.
