THE STOCK DISEASES REGULATIONS, 1933

THE DIPPING OF STOCK NOTICE, 1984

(Under regulation 11)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by regulation 11 of the Stock Diseases Regulations, 1933, I hereby issue the following Notice —

Citation and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Dipping of Stock Notice, 1984 and shall come into force on the 9th November, 1984.

Compulsory dipping of stock.

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) all owners of cattle in Swaziland shall dip their cattle once every seven days.

(2) Owners of cattle in Schedule hereto shall dip their cattle once every fourteen (14) days.

Dipping hours.

3. Subject to any directions to the contrary issued by an officer authorised under regulation 11, dipping hours under regulation 2 of this Notice shall be between 7.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon.

Revocation of Legal No. 71 of 1984.

4. The Dipping of Stock Notice, 1984 is hereby revoked.

THE DAIRY ACT, 1968

(Act No. 28 of 1968)

THE PRICES OF LIQUID MILK REGULATIONS, 1984

(Under Section 24)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 24 of the Dairy Act, 1968 the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives, after consultation with the Swaziland Dairy Board hereby makes the following Regulations.

Citation and Commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prices of Liquid Milk Regulations, 1984 and shall come into force on 19th November, 1984.

Minimum Price to be paid to a Producer of Milk.

2. The Price to be paid by a milk Processor to a milk Producer for fresh milk delivered by him to such processor shall be not less than 25 cents a Litre.

Maximum price to be paid to a milk processor of fresh cow's milk by a milk purveyor.

3. The price to be paid by a milk purveyor of liquid milk for fresh cow's milk delivered to him by a processor shall be 84 cents per Litre for packaged milk or 82 cents per Litre of bulk milk.

Maximum selling price of liquid fresh cow's milk.

4. The maximum selling price of fresh cow's milk by dairies, milk shops and milk purveyors to the public shall be 88 cents per Litre for cartoned milk.

Maximum price to be paid to a milk processor of cultured milk (Emasi) by a milk purveyor.

5. The price paid by a purveyor of cultured milk (Full Cream Emasi) delivered to him by a processor shall be 76 cents per Litre for full cream cultured Emasi.

Maximum selling price of cultured milk (Emasi).

6. The maximum selling price of cultured milk (Emasi) by dairies, milk shops and milk purveyors to the public shall be 80 cents per Litre for cartoned full cream emasi; 74 cents per Litre for bulk full cream emasi.

Revocation of Legal Notice No. 74 of 1984.

7. The Prices of Liquid Milk Regulations, 1984 are hereby revoked.

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prices of Powdered Milk and Allied Products Regulations, 1984 and shall come into force on the 19th November, 1984.

Maximum Wholesale and Retail Selling Price.

2. The maximum wholesale and retail selling prices of powdered milk and allied products in Swaziland shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto.

Revocation of Legal Notice No. 61 of 1983.

3. The Prices of Powdered Milk and Allied Products Regulations, 1983 are hereby revoked.

- (iv) Articulated Vehicles — "Articulated vehicle" means a single operative motor vehicle consisting of a power unit (tractor) coupled with and partly bearing a detachable goods or passenger carrying unit or combination thereof having no front axle (semi-trailer). Each unit of an articulated vehicle is rated and insured separately in respect of the tractor unit under group reference 7 and in respect of the semi-trailer unit according to the purpose for which such unit is designed or used, I.B. under group references 2A, 2B, 2C, 3A, 3B, 3C, as the case may be.
- (v) Station wagons and similar type vehicles if used for the carrying of trade goods the vehicle must be rated under group references 2A, 2B or 2C.
