The appointees shall remain members of the committee for a period not exceeding three years from the date of coming into force of this Notice.

Functions of the Committee

- 4. The Committee shall perform the following functions -
- (1) conduct investigations as to whether or not the whole or part of any service is an essential service, and to decide whether or not to designate the whole or part of a service as an essential service;

- (2) determine disputes as to whether or not the whole or part of any service is an essential service;
- (3) determine whether or not the whole or part of any service is a minimum maintenance service; and
 - (4) Any other functions as provided for in the Industrial Relations Act, 2000.

Allowances and Fees

5. Members of the Committee including the Secretary shall receive allowances in terms of the relevant finance circulars issued from time to time.
