THE APPROPRIATION BILL, 1984

(Bill No. 1 of 1984)

(To be presented by the Minister for Finance)

MEMORANDUM IN TERMS OF THE STANDING ORDERS OF PARLIAMENT

The object of this Bill is to charge the Consolidated Fund with the sum of two and eleven million, eight hundred and nine thousand Emalangeni (E211,809,000) commencing on the 1st April, 1984 and ending on the 31st March, 1985.

The sum is to be appropriated in the manner set out in the Schedule to this Bill.

A BILL entitled

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1984 and ending on the 31st March, 1985.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1984 and shall come into force on the 1st of April, 1984.

Charge to the Consolidated Fund.

2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with such sum not exceeding in the aggregate two hundred and eleven million, eight hundred and nine thousand Emalangeni (211,809,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1984 and ending on the 31st March, 1985.

3. The sum appropriated under section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the first column of the Schedule and in the respective amounts appearing in the second and third columns in respect of each service.
