PRICE CONTROL ORDER, 1973

(Order No. 25 of 1973)

MAXIMUM WHOLESALE AND RETAIL PRICES OF BREAD NOTICE, 1988

(Under Section 5)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 5 of the Price Control Order, 1973 I hereby issue the following Notice—

Citation and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Maximum Wholesale and Retail Prices of Bread Notice, 1988 and shall come into force on 9th December, 1988.

Maximum prices of bread.

2. The maximum wholesale and retail prices of bread other than fancy bread, shall be as set out in the schedule below.

Revocation of Legal Notice No. 3 of 1988.

3. The Maximum Wholesale and Retail Prices of Bread Notice, 1988 is hereby revoked.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 135 OF 1988

SWAZILAND NATIONAL PROVIDENT FUND ORDER, 1974

(Order No. 23 of 1974)

STATUTORY CONTRIBUTIONS REGULATIONS, 1988

(Under Sections 14, 15 & 17)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 14, 15 and 17 of the Swaziland National Provident Fund Order, 1974 and after consultation with the Minister for Finance, the Minister for Labour and Public Service hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Swaziland National Provident Fund (Statutory Contributions) Regulations, 1988, and shall come into force on the 1st January, 1989.

Wages level for statutory contributions.

2. A contributing employer shall only pay statutory Contributions in respect of an eligible employees wages of E200 or less during any calendar month.

Statutory contributions.

3. After every contribution period, a contributing employer shall pay into the Fund a statutory contribution at the rate prescribed in the Schedule hereto in respect of each eligible employee employed by him during such period.

Employee's share.

4. A contributing employer who is required to pay a statutory contribution in respect of an employee may deduct the "employee's share" of such contribution from the wages due from him to that employee at the rate prescribed in the Schedule hereto.

Revocation of Legal Notice No. 103 of 1986.

5. The Statutory Contributions Order, 1986 is hereby revoked.
