THE CATTLE DIPPING CHARGES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1994 (Bill No. 9 of 1994)

(to be presented by the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives)

MEMERANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to amend the Cattle Dipping Charges Act, 1950 to enable the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives to charge all owners of cattle, whether on title deed land or Swazi Nation land, who use public dips for dipping their cattle such fee per beast per annum as he may be Notice in the Gazette prescribe from time to time.

A BILL entitled

An Act to amend the Cattle Dipping Charges Act, 1950.

ENACTED by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title.

 This Act may be cited as the Cattle Dipping Charges (Amendment) Act, 1994 and shall be read as one with the Cattle Dipping Charges Act, 1950 hereinafter in this Act referred to as the "principal Act".

Amendment of long title.

2. The long title to the principal Act is hereby replaced with the following:-

"An Act to consolidate and amend the laws relating to the imposition and recovery of charges for the dipping of cattle by cattle owners at public dips which are supplied with dipping material by the Government".

Amendment of section 2.

- 3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended as follows:
 - (a) by replacing the definition "public dip" and "owner" respectively in subsection (1) with the following -

"public dip" means any dipping tank for dipping cattle and for the use of which the dipping material is supplied by the Government;

"owner" means any person who owns or has in his custody cattle which are being dipped at a public dip except that cattle under the control of the Government for the purposes of the Animal Diseases Act, 1965 shall not be deemed to be in the custody of the Government but shall, for the purposes of this Act, be deemed to be in the custody of the "owner".

(b) by repealing subsection (2).

Amendment of section 3.

- 4. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by replacing subsection (1) with the following -
 - "3. (1) The owner shall pay to the Government for each year in respect of each head of cattle that is dipped in a public dip such fee and at such periods as the Minister may prescribe from time to time by Notice published in the Gazette."

Amendment of section 4.

- 5. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by replacing it with the following new section -
 - "4. (1) A person who fails or neglects to pay fees prescribed under section 3 (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon conviction by a court of law to a fine not exceeding two thousand Emalangeni (E2,000.00) or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two (2) years.
 - (2) The court may, on application by the prosecution and in addition to the penalty referred to in sub-section (1) order the convicted person to pay the prescribed fees owed by that person.

Insertion of new section 5.

- The principal Act is amended by inserting after section 4 the following new section "Regulations.
- 5. The Minister may make regulations for the better carrying out of the objects of this Act."
