THE COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963  
(Act No. 35 of 1963)

THE COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY INTO THE OPERATIONS OF THE  
SWAZILAND NATIONAL PROVIDENT FUND (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 2001  
(Under section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commission of Enquiry Act, 1963 I hereby issue the following Notice -

*Citation*

1. This Notice may be cited as the Commission of Enquiry into the operations of the Swaziland National Provident Fund (Amendment) Notice, 2001 and shall be read as one with the Commission of Enquiry into the Operations of the Swaziland National Provident Fund Notice No. 129 of 2000.

*Amendment of Legal Notice No. 129 of 2000*

2. Legal Notice No. 129 of 2000 is amended by replacing paragraph 8 with the following new paragraph -

**“Payment of allowances**

8. (1) Members of the Commission shall be paid such allowances as may be determined by the Minister.
- (2) Sub-paragraph (1) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2000.”
