LEGAL NOTICE NO. 65 OF 2001

THE BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS ACT, 1963 (Act No. 20 of 1963)

BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS (EXEMPTION) NOTICE, 2001 (Under Section 11)

In exercise of the powers vested by Section 11 of the Books and Newspapers Act 1963, the Minister for Public Service and Information issues the following Notice -

Short tittle and Commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Books and Newspapers (Exemption) Notice, 2001 and shall come into force on the date of publication.

Exemption of Books and Newspapers

- 2. (1) A person who has been carrying on the business of printing or publishing a book or newspaper for the past five years is exempt from complying with the provisions of Part IV of this Act.
 - (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), such person shall produce proof of insurance to the Registrar.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 66 OF 2001

THE BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS ACT, 1963 (Act No. 20 of 1963)

THE BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2001 (Under Section 18)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Books and Newspapers Act, 1963 the Minister for Public Service and Information issues the following Notice.

Citation.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Books and Newspapers (Amendment) Regulations, 2001 and shall be read as one with the books and Newspapers Regulations, 1963 (hereinafter referred to in these Regulations as the "principal Regulations".

Amendment of the Schedule.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by replacing the Schedule to the principal Regulations with a new Schedule as follows-
