LEGAL NOTICE NO. 184 OF 2007

THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (Act No. 35 of 1963)

THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TRAINING AND LOCALIZATION COMMITTEE NOTICE, 2007. (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment issues the following Notice -

Citation and Commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the Training and Localization Committee Notice, 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th November, 2007.

Establishment and Composition of Committee

- 2. There is established a Committee to be known as the Training and Localisation Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Committee") which shall be composed of the following persons -
 - (a) Substantive Members
 - (i) Winnie Magagula Chairperson
 - (ii) Zodwa Mabuza Employer's Representative
 - (iii) Jimson S. Gwebu Worker's Representative
 - (iv) Joeking Dlamini Workers' Representative
 - (v) Thembinkosi Mamba Government Representative
 - (vi) Sipho Hlophe Government Representative
 - (vii) Moses Z. Gamedze Secretary
 - (b) Alternate Members
 - (i) Rev. Abednego M. Dlamini Chairperson
 - (ii) Sipho Ndzimandze Government
 - (iii) Bongani Mtshali Employer
 - (iv) Rodgers Lukhele Workers
 - (v) Samuel Shongwe Workers
 - (vi) Dickson Z. Mkhonta Government
 - (vii) Nobantu B. Masuku Government

Functions of the Committee

- 3. The Committee shall perform the following functions -
 - (a) hold meetings the purpose of which is to discuss issues pertaining to training and localisation.
 - (b) carry out regular visits to industries with a view to monitor compliance with the aims and objectives of the training and localisation policy;
 - (c) provide guidance to the Immigration Department on the issuance of work permits; and to:
 - (d) provide advice to the Minister of Enterprise and Employment on issues pertaining to appointment of locals into senior positions in industries.

Terms of office

4. The term of office of the Committee shall not exceed three years.

Allowances

The Committee shall be entitled to such allowance and, where applicable, re-imbursement for travelling expenses in accordance with the Finance Circular No. 4 of 1998 or any such circular which may from time to time be issued.

Frequency of meetings

6. The Committee shall hold at least two meetings per month but shall not hold more than meeting in a month without first obtaining the written approval of the Minister.

Quorum

7. The chairperson and three members, one representing Government, one representing Employers and one representing workers shall constitute a quorum.

Submission of Report

8. The Committee shall submit a report on its functions to the Minister every six months from date of appointment and whenever so required by the Minister.

Extension of term of appointment

9. The Minister may, by Notice published in the Gazette, extend the period stated in section 4.

Revocation of Legal No. 163 of 2004

10. Legal Notice No. 163 of 2004 is hereby revoked.
